Heritage Adventurer is a true pioneering expedition vessel of exceptional pedigree. Often referred to as the 'Grande Dame of Expedition Cruising' due to her celebrated history and refined design. She was purpose-built for adventure in 1991 in Finland and specifically designed for Polar exploration. Originally designed to accommodate 184 guests, Heritage Adventurer now welcomes just 140 guests ensuring spacious, stylish, and comfortable voyages, while a fleet of 14 Zodiacs enables all guests to maximize their expedition adventure. Onboard, visit the captain and crew on the bridge thanks to the ship's Open Bridge Policy; dine on international gourmet fare from leading chefs across two restaurants, and celebrate the day's activities in the Bar and Lounge. Watch your adventure unfold from numerous spectacular viewing locations including the Observation Lounge, replendent with 270-degree views, or the open-topped Observation Deck where you can enjoy 360-degree views from the highest point on the ship.

Not Included

Costs not included in the price of your Apex expedition include travel to and from the start and end point of trip; select premium brand drinks and liquor; travel protection (Trip Cancellation and Interruption, as well as Emergency Medical and Evacuation insurance, are highly recommended); airport departure taxes; equipment rental; excess baggage fees; passport and/or visa fees; items of a personal nature (phone calls, laundry, souvenirs, etc.); and independent travel arrangements pre- or post-trip.


Payments & Terms

25% of the trip cost will confirm your place on the expedition. The final balance is due 150 days prior to departure. All prices are quoted in U.S. dollars and must be paid in U.S. dollars. Per person pricing is based on double occupancy. The solo rate is paid by participants who specifically request single accommodations and is subject to availability. If you are traveling alone and wish to share accommodations, we will try to match you with a roommate of the same gender. However, if a roommate is not available, the published solo rate will be charged. Upon confirming your reservation you will be required to pay the published Solo Rate, if we are able to pair you with a roommate, the applicable difference will be refunded at the time that the final trip payment is due for all participants. Please note that solo accommodations are limited and cannot always be guaranteed throughout. 
Deck Plan – Heritage Adventurer

Located on Deck 6, Heritage Suites are an expansive 475 square feet and feature large double panoramic windows, king bed, large living area with a sofa, coffee table and chairs, large writing desk, grand marble bathroom with a double basin, bathtub and shower, floor to ceiling storage, and a flat-screen entertainment system.



Located on Deck 6, Worsley Suites are spacious 235 square feet in size and feature large panoramic windows, king or two single beds, comfortable chaise-style lounge suite, writing desk, private en-suite bathroom with shower, ample storage, and a flat-screen entertainment system.



Superior Cabins on Decks 4 and 5 are a spacious 235 square feet and feature large panoramic windows, king or two single beds, lounge area, writing desk, private en-suite bathroom with shower, ample storage, and a flat-screen entertainment system.



Superior Solo Cabins on Deck 5 are a spacious 235 square feet in size and feature large panoramic windows, king bed, lounge area, writing desk, private en-suite bathroom with shower, ample storage, and a flat-screen entertainment system.
